About the BMS Ambassadors Programme

The British Music Society is initiating a BMS Ambassador programme that offers a fee of £300 to an individual professional performer working internationally to give a masterclass on purely British music at an overseas institution.

Ambassadors must be a member of the BMS when they represent the Society in this capacity and will be responsible for setting up the masterclass with a host organisation. The host, in turn, provides the use of a venue and the participating students free of charge to the BMS, whose logo will feature on all material relating to the masterclass and whose leaflets will be available on the day.

The Ambassador's fee will be paid after receipt of a written report (half or full page) and photographs for use in its news and social media; this material needs to be submitted within one month of the event.

A maximum of two BMS Ambassadors will be appointed a year and instrumentalists are invited to submit an application by completing the accompanying form.

Singers may not apply as the Society already supports an annual competition/masterclass in the form of BASC (British Art Song Competition).
